THE GOAL OF THE CASE STORY IS TO PRACTICE TAKING DIFFERENT PERSPECTIVES, IDENTIFYING THE EXPECTATIONS OF EACH PARTY, AND REFLECTING UPON ONE'S OWN EXPECTATIONS. ADDITIONALLY, THE PURPOSE IS TO GENERATE SOLUTIONS WHILE CONSIDERING THE FACT THAT THE CHARACTERS IN THE STORY, AS WELL AS OTHER PARTICIPANTS, MAY INTERPRET THE SAME SITUATION DIFFERENTLY. FINALLY, THIS CASE STORY AIMS TO ADDRESS POWER IMBALANCES IN THE CONTEXT OF PROVIDING HELP, SPECIFICALLY HIGHLIGHTING THAT A PERSON PROVIDING ASSISTANCE OFTEN HAS EASIER ACCESS TO KNOWLEDGE AND RESOURCES.
